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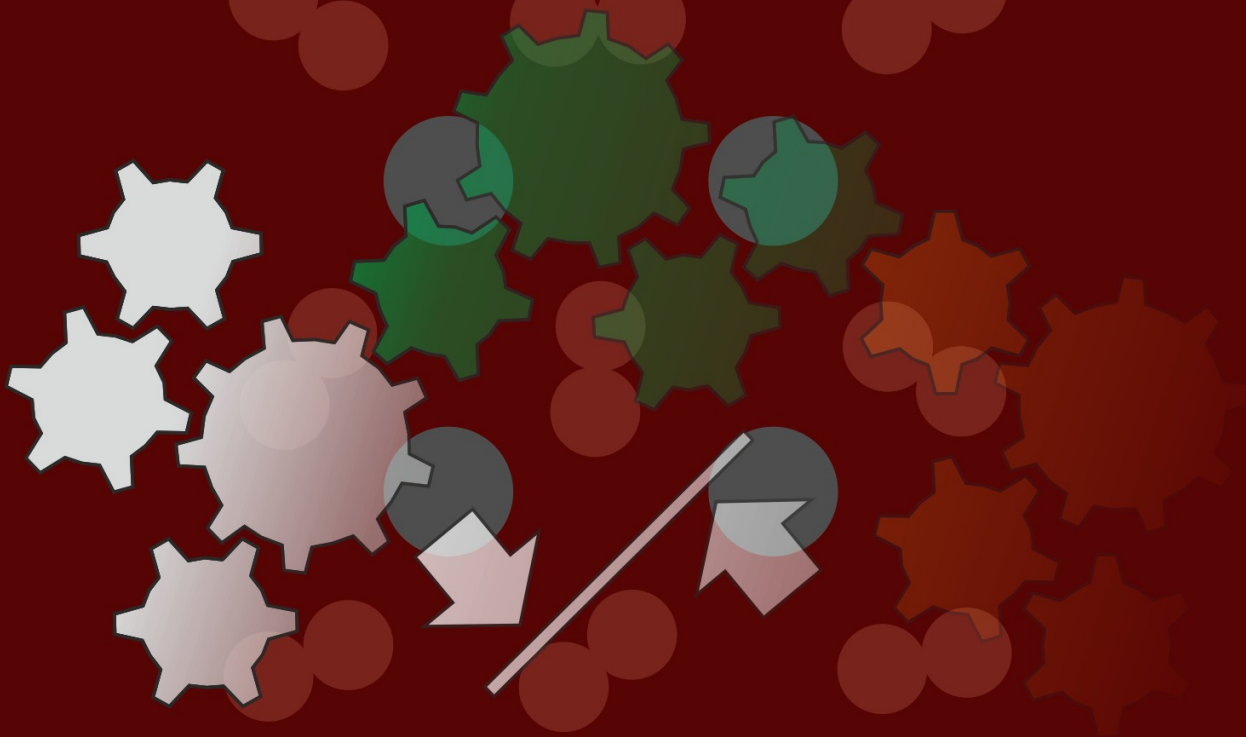
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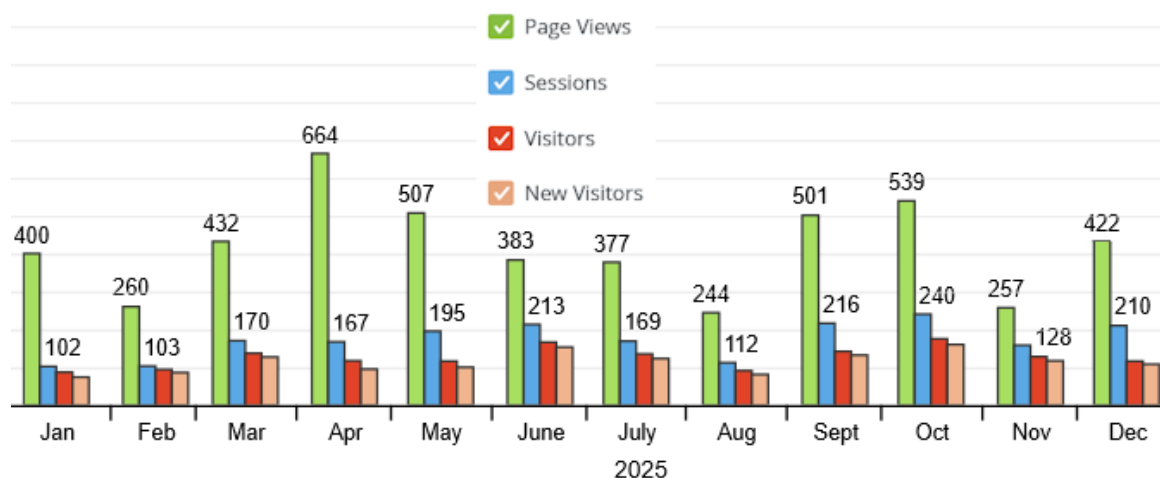
Editors' Note

Journal statistics for 2025:

- *Acta Tecnologia* published 26 peer-reviewed articles.
- 33 submitted manuscripts were not accepted for publication.
- The total number of printed pages published in the journal was 211 pages.
- A total of 57 authors and co-authors contributed to the published articles, many of which have already received citations.



In 2025, *Acta Tecnologia* recorded significant website traffic not only across Europe but also worldwide. According to the annual web analysis, the journal was accessed from more than 102 countries globally: Average monthly page views: 414, Average monthly visitors: 122, Average monthly new visitors: 110.
